

Bilingual Double Master of Law with King's College London

● Description

The Double Master of Law, started jointly with the Faculty of Law of King's College London, provides a bilingual education in French and English across two university campuses, with half the courses taught at Neuchâtel, and the other half at London. The component at Neuchâtel has nine different specializations, of which students are free to choose at least one.

This unique programme, which usually lasts four semesters, leads to a double qualification, i.e. a Master of Law from Neuchâtel and an LL.M from King's College London.

● Strengths

- Bilingualism (with the writing of one dissertation in English)
- Familiarization with another legal tradition
- A broad range of courses
- International exchange programmes, with minimal administrative complexity
- The opportunity to discover another culture
- The chance to undertake an internship during studies.

● Study programmes

● In Neuchâtel (60 ECTS)

The study programme in Neuchâtel has no obligatory component:

- **Elective courses and/or themed seminar modules**, to be chosen from the syllabus of Master of Law courses (totalling 60 ECTS).

For a bilingual Master of Law degree with specialization, the following requirements must be met:

- **Courses** (totalling 48 ECTS), whether:
 - Specialization-oriented courses (totalling 32 ECTS), including obligatory courses and elective specialization-oriented courses; and
 - Elective courses, to be chosen from those on the general Master of Law syllabus (totalling 16 ECTS).
- **Three themed seminar modules** totalling 12 ECTS), of which at least one is specialization-oriented.

● In London (60 ECTS)

The study programme in London has two components:

- **Courses** to be chosen from the syllabus of the LL.M programme of the School of Law at King's College London
- **Dissertation in English**, which may be co-supervised by a professor from the School of Law at King's College London and a professor from the Faculty of Law of the University of Neuchâtel.
