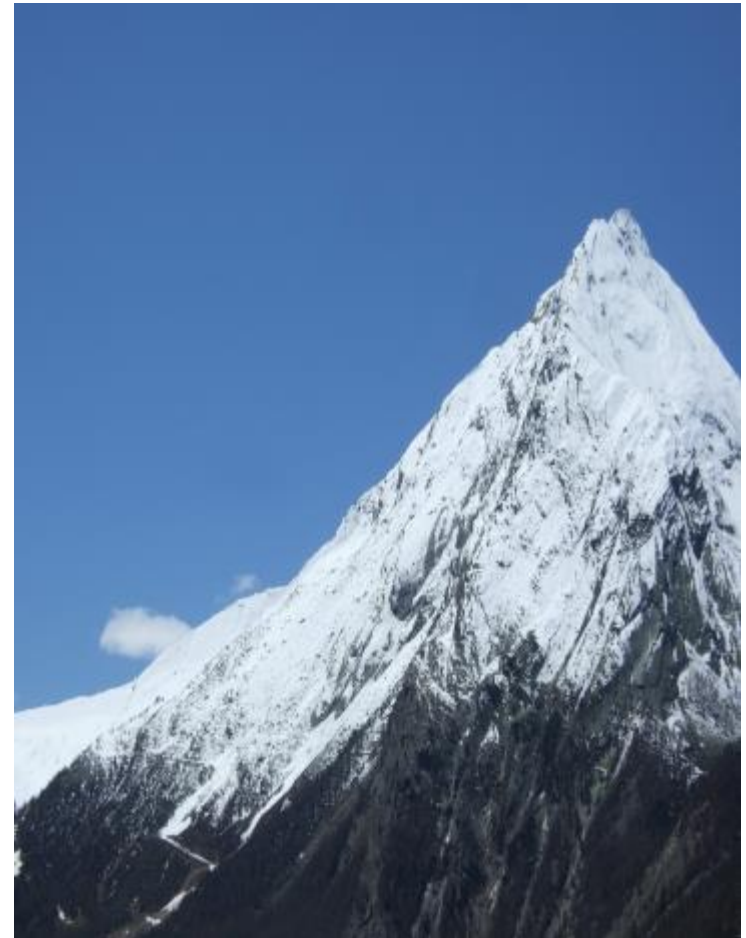

# Easy Budget : No need to calculate

It is predetermined based on 3 questions

- 1) Are you experienced ?
  - 2) Do you have a family ?
  - 3) Where is the host organization ?
- At the deadline  
of the call**

# Basic numbers

Research unit cost person/month			Institutional unit cost person/month	
Living allowance *	Mobility allowance	Family allowance	Research, training and networking costs	Management and indirect costs
4'560 €	600 €	500 €	800 €	650 €

Institutional unit costs are paid to the institution and are not part of your salary

# Examples of salary per month

➤ **Coming to Switzerland** (Coefficient : 113.1%)

- $4'560 \times 113.1\% = 5'157.36 \text{ €}$
- $+ 600 \text{ €} + 500 \text{ €} = 6'257.36 \text{ €}$
- $6'257.36 \text{ €} \times 1.0512 = 6'577.74 \text{ CHF}$

➤ **Going to Italy** (Coefficient : 106.7%)

- $4'560 \times 106.7\% = 4'865.52 \text{ €}$
- $+ 600 \text{ €} + 500 \text{ €} = 5'965.52 \text{ €}$
- **Top-up is possible**

# Two types of fellowships

- European Fellowships (IF)
  - Mobility within Europe
  
- Global Fellowship (GF)
  - Mobility outside Europe
  - return phase in Europe or Associated Country

# Country Status

- Member state (**MS**)
- Associated country (**AC**)
  - non-EU countries that are associated to Horizon 2020
- Third country (**TC**)
  - neither EU Member States (MS) nor associated to Horizon 2020 (AC)

# Mobility Rule

- From any country to
  - IF : a MS or AC
  - GF : a TC, with return phase to MS or AC
  
- the researcher must not have lived, worked, or studied in the MS, AC or TC of **Host** for more than 12 months during the 3 years prior to deadline



# Who is what ?

## ➤ Beneficiary

- the host organisation who recruits, supervises and provides training for the researcher, taking complete responsibility for executing the proposed action

## ➤ Researcher

- Experienced Researcher (ER) : at the deadline for the submission of proposals, be in possession of a doctoral degree or have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience

## ➤ Partner

- organisations provide additional training and host researchers during secondments.

# Contracts ?

- No consortium agreement :
  - this is a mono-beneficiary action
  
- Grant Agreement between Commission/REA and beneficiary
  
- Partner organizations (**if any**) :
  - Cannot employ researcher
  - **Should** have partnership agreement with beneficiary

# Contracts ?

- Researcher must be recruited under an employment contract with the Host organization, including, among others,
  - Monthly support for researcher
  - Obligation to work solely for the action, and not to receive other incomes for same activities
  - Arrangements related to IP rights between beneficiary and researcher
  - ...
