1: What is included in the Switzerland agreement?

- Unlimited OA publishing in more than 900 Hybrid titles*, with no APC payable
- A 20% discount on list rate APCs in Gold Open Access Journals
- Option of a CC-BY, CC-BY-NC (or CC-BY-NC-ND) license, chosen by the Author
- Read access rights to the journals your institutions subscribes to

*Publishing rights apply where:

- The corresponding author is a staff member or student of a member institution, at the time of submission
- The article enters production (post acceptance) between the 1st of January 2021 and 31st of December 2022 and while the institution subscribes to their respective package
- The journal is part of the Premier collection
- The article is "Article type" (some commercially sponsored articles, invited articles, book reviews and other content types are excluded)
- Authors accept the offer within 2 weeks of being contacted.

2: What is SAGE's Open Access Portal?

The **SAGE Open Access Portal** is an integrated online platform that provides a single portal for authors, consortia, libraries and funders to manage open access publishing across more than 1000 journals published by SAGE including titles published on behalf of, or in association with, over 400 societies. Launched in 2020, the SAGE Open Access Portal supports SAGE Choice, our hybrid OA publishing option, for 800+ journals and SAGE's 180+ pure Gold Open Access journals.



2: What is SAGE's Open Access Portal?

For Authors it will:

- · Automatically identify and contact all authors who are eligible for the Switzerland Open Access Agreement with SAGE
- Provide the appropriate Creative Commons license which they, or any co-author, can digitally sign, quickly and easily.
- For Gold OA Journal Articles: Provide a fully integrated online payment system to manage the APC transaction process, including automatically applying any applicable discounts, waivers or taxes.
- Send automated reminders and updates on any activities relating to their article(s) in the portal.
- Create a personal login account within the portal from which to view and track the open access status of any article(s) on which they are an author or co-author.

2: What is SAGE's Open Access Portal?

For Institutions it will:

- Automate the terms of the Switzerland Read and Publish agreement in a single uniform workflow.
- Automatically identify all eligible articles/authors to which to offer the Switzerland agreement publishing rights to; maximizing the uptake of their Open Access Agreement
- Communicate the Swiss agreed preference for Open Access publishing with their authors.
- Enable Centralized Bill Payer accounts to be set up through which institutions can pre-approve OA offers and to accept or decline to pay Gold OA APCs associated with authors at their institution or organization centrally.
- Provide reporting through various administrative dashboard views and downloadable report functions.

3: How are Eligible articles identified?


These next 3 slides take you through how a Corresponding Author declares their affiliation during submission, which we later use to decide automatically if a paper is eligible:



3: How are eligible articles identified?

Submission and Peer Review (ScholarOne): Author inputs institution (Ringgold ID)


- The options authors are shown populate as they type, similar to a google search.
- · This helps them correctly set their affiliation.
- The full list is provided to SAGE by Ringgold



3: How are eligible articles identified?

Submission and Peer Review (ScholarOne): Author inputs institution (Ringgold ID)

- An Author can enter an affiliation not on the list, but they are warned why this might not be advisable and have to do so proactively
- If an author doesn't chose a match, we attempt to match them to an affiliation using their e-mail domain



3: How are eligible articles identified?

Submission and Peer Review (ScholarOne):
Author inputs institution (Ringgold ID)

Production (SMART):

Ringgold and OpenFunder ID metadata checks by SAGE Production

Sales Deal Identifier module runs on all journal articles

Eligible articles routed to SAGE Open Access Portal

Then...

The next step happens post acceptance, when the article moves from editorial systems into production....

All articles **automatically, proactively** checked against the Switzerland Agreement parameters:

- Journal package list
- Contract dates
- Corresponding author Ringgold ID
- Article type

4a: Pre-Approve Workflow - Hybrid

These next 2 slides take you through how a hybrid identified article is presented to the University to approve or reject, in the Pre-Approve workflow. This happens <u>before</u> an offer of OA is made to the Authors.

- Swiss Authors will be offered a choice of CC-BY or CC-BY-NC here by default
- If they have declared a funder that requires a specific license (e.g. Wellcome funded articles) only the required license will be offered (e.g. CC-BY).
- Author may contact the customer service team
 - they require a license option not presented

For Hybrid OA, articles are free, so this is the end of the process.

These next 7 slides take you through how an Author is offered the Open Access publishing for a Gold OA article, and the steps they take in the system when the Institution (CBP) has agreed to be the bill payer. If the institution has not agreed to be the bill payer, the author will be presented with the APC information and will need to arrange for payment instead of the institution.



6: CBP dashboards, billing and reporting

These next 3 slides take you through the CBP (institutional) dashboard, showing actions needed, reporting available, billing options (for Gold OA articles) and article status.



6: CBP (institutional) Dashboard



This is the home screen for Institutional administrators.

From here, institutions can monitor articles awaiting approval, assign payment methods to APCs and manage their prepaid or aggregate billing. They can also download reports.

 For the Pre-Approve workflow, this will show all articles including hybrid OA approval requests
